Christmas Lunch On Jesus

Raising funds for the CLOJ project 2020 has started!

So exciting to be serving families in need, with a Christmas Lunch on Jesus. The CLOJ team are going ahead as if Auckland is in Covid-19 level 1. However, should the levels change the packing day will be split into two distinct days, one for packing perishables and the other for non-perishables. While the demand for food parcels is higher than ever before, we realise people's ability to finance a box may be more difficult. Therefore, the price of the lunch box will be kept to \$70 per box. to be consistent with previous years. We are also conscious the CLOJ project needs to be self-sustaining and not draw on the church's finances. The team again aims to provide a minimum of 160 boxes and a max of 200 boxes to families in need.
